

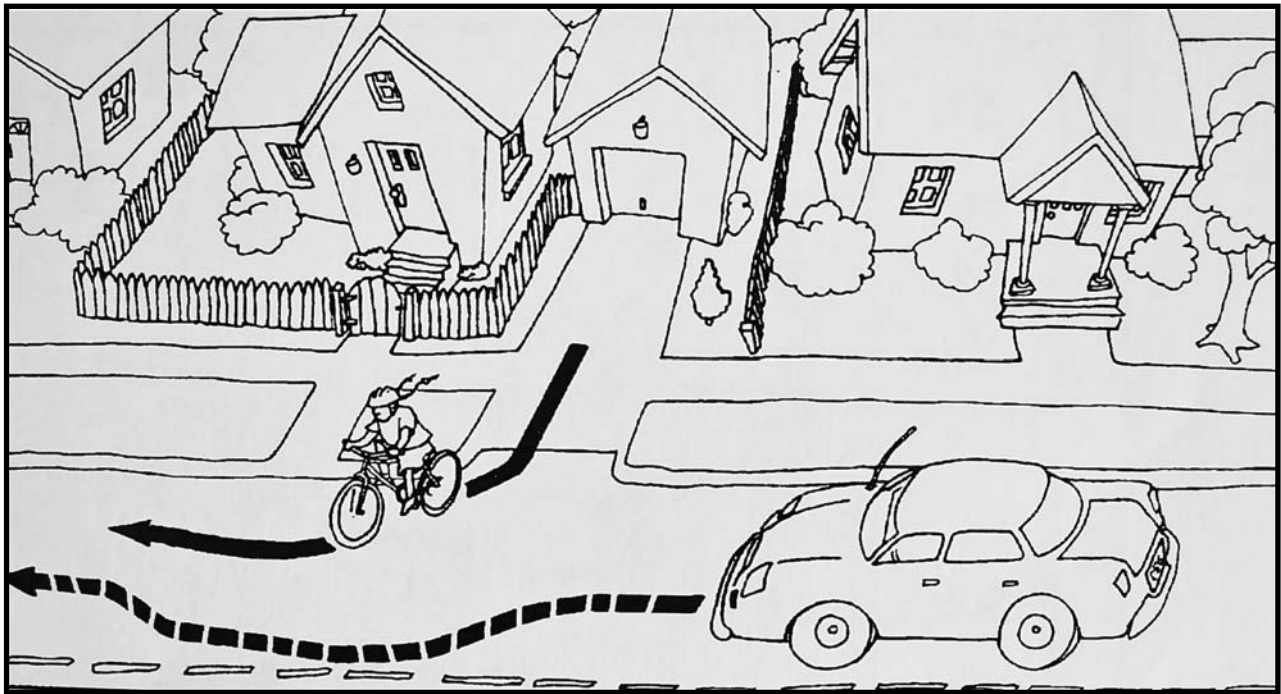
CRASH CASE STUDY #2
