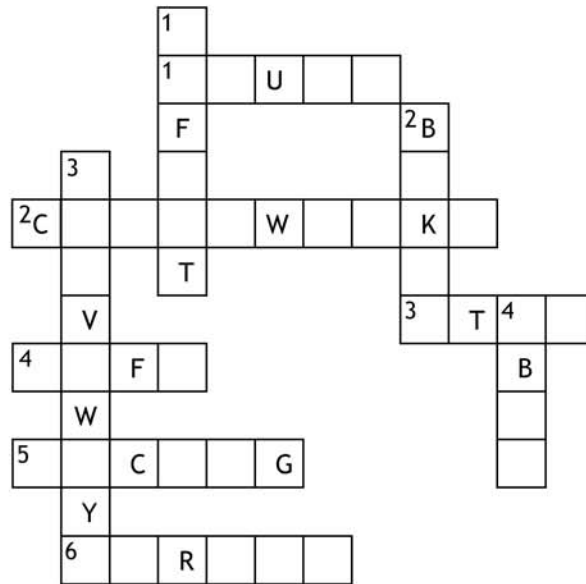


PEDESTRIAN SAFETY
