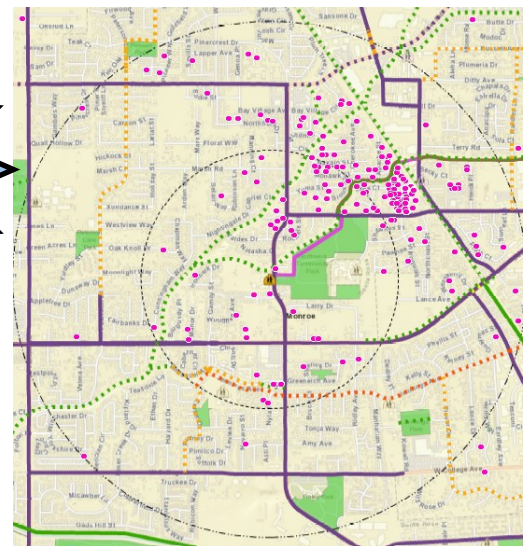

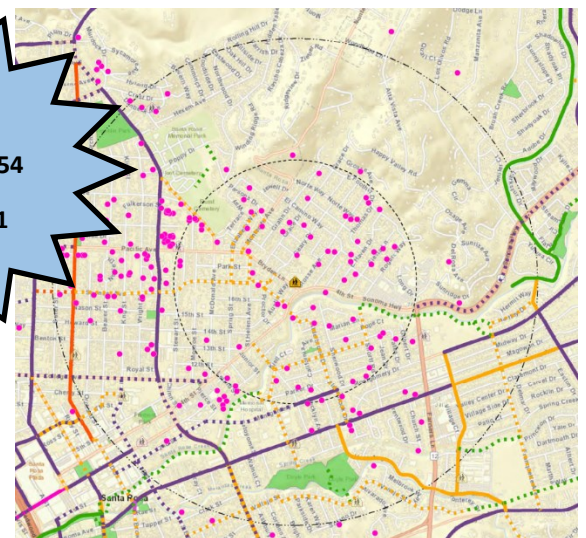
### GIS Student Address Map

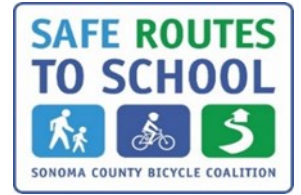

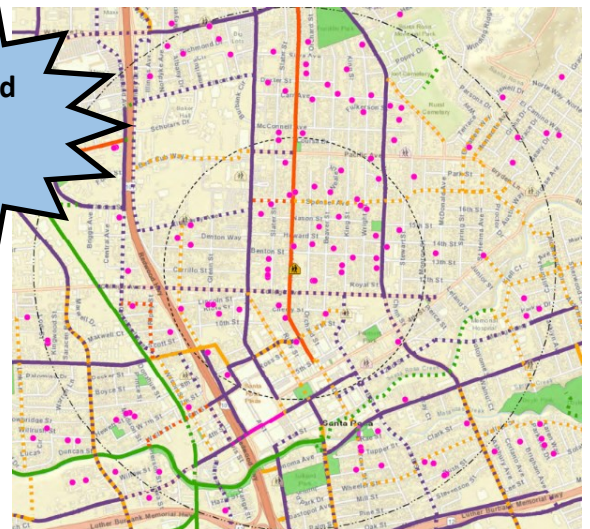
#### GIS Student Address Map
