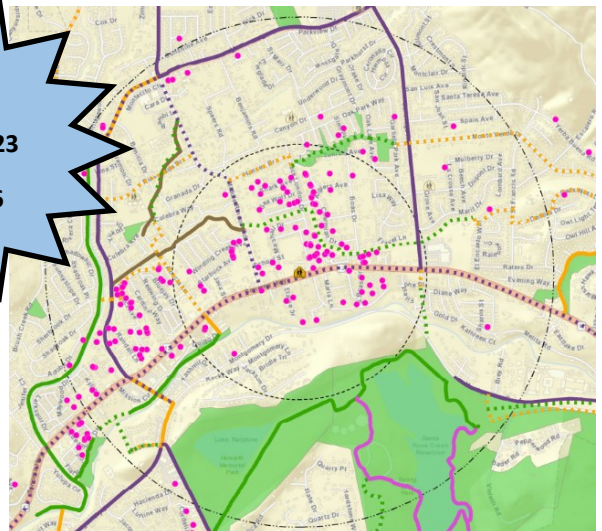

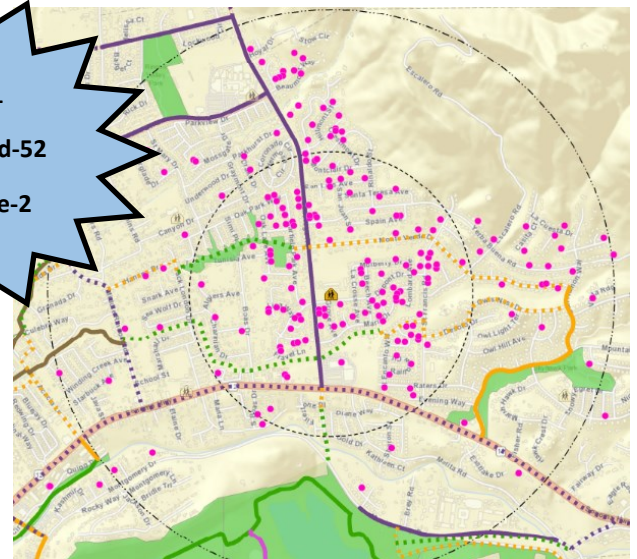

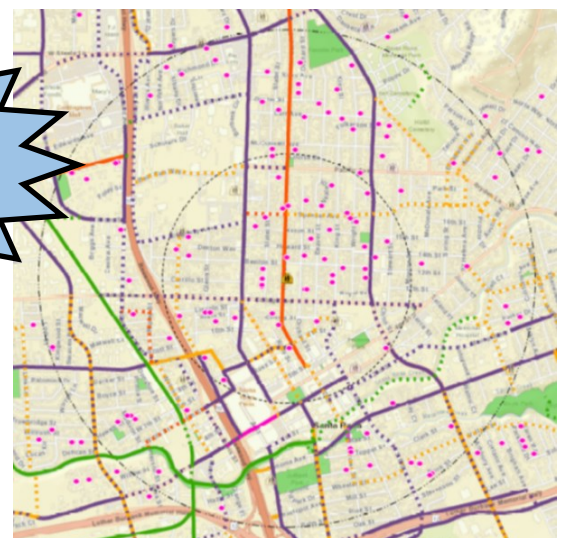

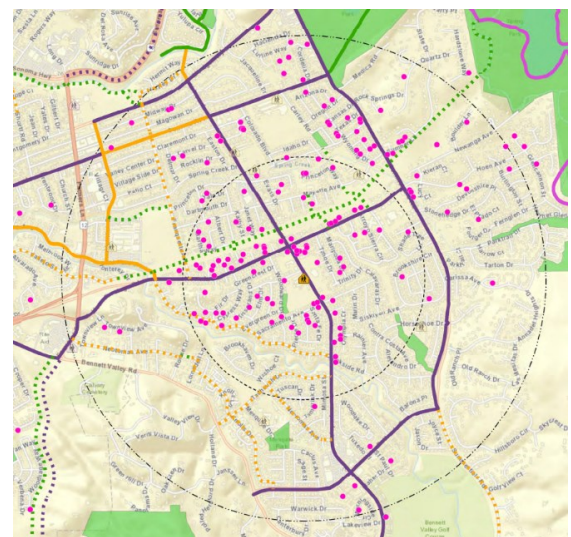

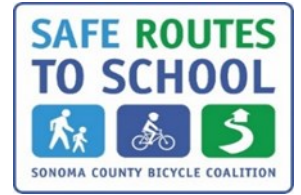

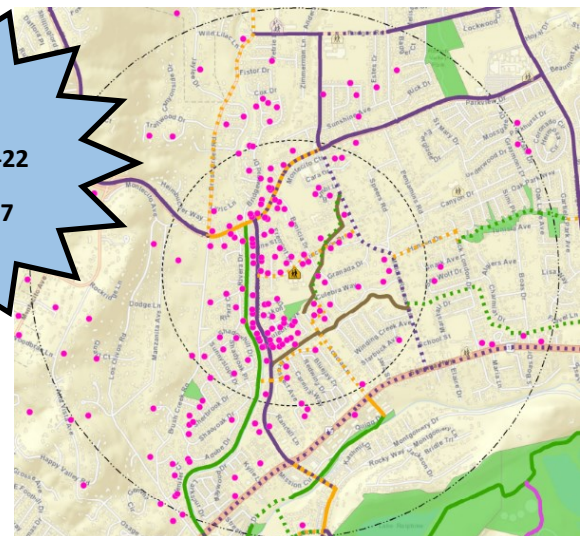
### GIS Student Address Map

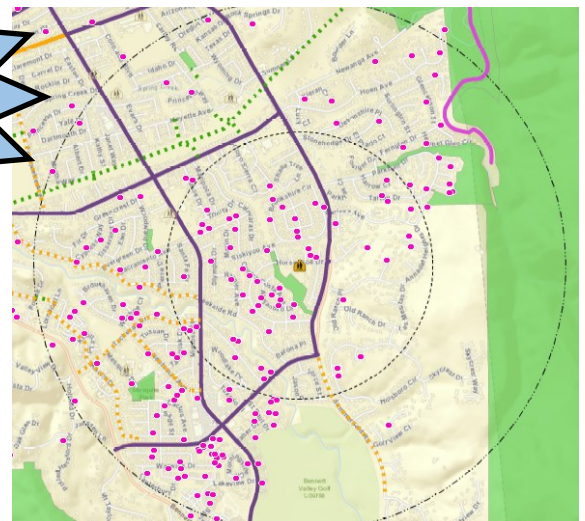

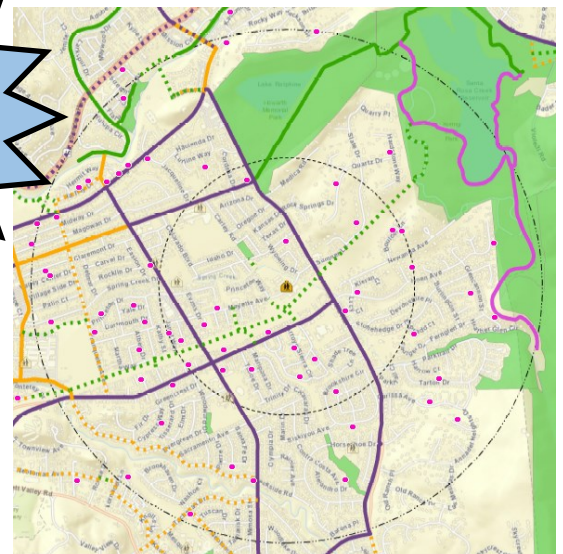

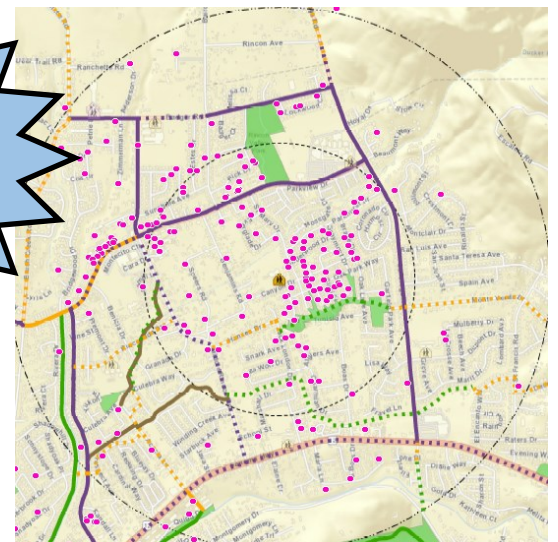
