

- Include your name, school, grade level, and homeroom teacher, and a way to contact you (phone or email)



1 mile of walking/biking

= 200 Penguin Miles

New bird observation

= 100 Penguin Miles

Read a book about penguins or California/western Birds

= 100 Penguin Miles (each book)

Watch the documentary March of the Penguins (Apple TV) or The Sub-Zero World of Penguins (YouTube)

= 100 Penauin Miles (each movie)

Watch the YouTube Videos = 100 Penauin Miles "California Birds" Episodes 1 &/or 2 (each video)

(or another documentary on California or western Birds)

or anywhere each day in March, plus observations and books/documentaries (attach extra sheets if needed
