The winning designs will be printed, artwork on front and haiku on back, and distributed to schools and local libraries in Sonoma County.

- Each entry must be the original work of one child. No copyrighted images (characters, logos, etc.) or computer designs. Design your bookmark in the space provided on THIS entry form and return the whole form intact.
- Any 2D art medium may be used (crayon, markers, colored pencil). No 3D materials (glitter, glued items, etc.) Designs and words must be dark enough to be reproducible.
- Contest ends March 1, 2019, 4:30PM.
- Contest is open to students in grades 2-8 who live in or attend school in Sonoma County. Winner selected by Sonoma County SRTS Staff.
